Dear Parents,

May we remind you that the school is to remain open on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2014, but that the transport and canteen services will not operate. Please make sure that your child has sandwiches and drinks for his/her lunch break.

Children who come to school shall be taken care of, however we cannot be certain that lessons will run as normal.

So that the end of lessons goes smoothly, please indicate in your child's agenda whether s/he must go to the Commission *garderie* or if s/he is being picked up by parents at the end of the school day. Children enrolled in the Commission *garderie* will go to room S.0.01 (ERASME), where they will be looked after by the *garderie* staff before being escorted to the onsite *garderie* in the PLATON building – R008 (Cafeteria).

Children of the 2<sup>nd</sup> year primary who are being collected by their parents will go to room S.0.01 (ERASME), where parents may collect them between 15.45 and 16.05.

Children of 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> year primary will go to the Chaussée de Waterloo gate, where they will be collected by their parents between 15.45 and 16.05.
