

MESSAGE FROM CANTEEN'S PRESIDENT

Dear parents,

This Thursday 14th of November at 7pm there is a General Assembly of the APEEE Services in which the **self service project** is going to be discussed and voted upon by your class reps.

On the top of all the information that we have been posting on this website I wanted to reassure some parents who are concerned with the quality of the food and about an old study of 2009 that has been circulating, and think we should concentrate our efforts on food quality instead of infrastructures.

In 2007 I took part at the working group that did the research for this study. Together with a group of parents we identified ways of improvement for our Canteen and in 2009 I took the presidency of the Canteen Committee from Mr. Kivinen. Since, and together with some other parents from the same group, we have been working towards better quality food. We hired a dietician and a new cook, we signed in our Canteen for the *Cantine Durable* program, cooking oils and techniques have improved, much more fresh food has been used, more soups, more vegetables...

A recurrent problem with the service has led us now to this new research path on the possibility of a self-service, which could generate savings to be reinvested on food quality.

So, if food quality is your concern, support the self-service project this coming Thursday!
