Classroom activity is combined with work experience in local cooperative enterprises, alongside real “cooptours”: purpose-built guided tours to help better understand cooperative best practices, concepts of economy and sociology, and knowledge of the natural and cultural heritage.

[European Coop Campus Young](#) is also a real opportunity to discover and live the mountains, lakes, culture and technology of Trentino... from a sailing boat, from trekking the tops of the world famous Dolomites, heritage of UNESCO, and from the innovative Science Museum MUSE.

WHERE?

[European Coop Campus Young](#) is held in Trentino (the North of Italy), an excellent tourist destination and one of the most important cooperative models in Italy and in Europe: with more than 500 cooperatives and 270,000 cooperative members in a population of half a million inhabitants, Trentino is a real and unique cooperative district, visited by many delegations and research institutes every year. A place where cooperation is an instrument that adds value not only to working life, but also to the local community, creating identity and a sense of belonging

WHO ORGANIZES IT?

[European Coop Campus Young](#) is promoted by the **Federazione Trentina della Cooperazione**, an institution that represents the cooperative system in Trentino, under the patronage of the **Autonomous Province di Trento**.

The Federation provides a team of professional educators with many years of experience in training cooperative members and in cooperative education in schools that involve thousands of students every year.

PROGRAMME

[European Coop Campus Young](#) is divided into modules, either as a short course of a week or more complete in a fortnight.

The programme, which will be in English, includes:

- high level training, both in the classroom and on the field
- experience of cooperative entrepreneurship
- cooperative film forum events
- sailing trips
- guided visits to the Unesco Heritage of the Dolomites
- guided visits to the Lake of Garda (the largest lake in Italy)
- trekking, biking and climbing expeditions.

The Federazione Trentina della Cooperazione is recognized authority for the validation of cooperative competences acquired in non-formal and informal contexts, accredited by the Autonomous Province of Trento for alternating school-work programs.
