## The possible scenarios according to the level of virus spread

### A. Definition of levels of virus spread

Experts distinguish 4 levels of virus spread that can be summarized as follows :

#### Zero risk - GREEN

- A vaccine is available and/or there is herd immunity. All contacts can take place. Hand hygiene (before eating and after going to the bathroom) remains necessary.

#### Low Risk – YELLOW

- Limited virus transmission is observed, vigilance is therefore recommended. Contacts between potential carriers are limited. Contacts that are necessary from a functional perspective can continue and are subject to applicable safety requirements.

#### Moderate risk – ORANGE

- Systematic transmission of the virus is observed in society. There are local outbreaks. Contacts between potential carriers are restricted to what is strictly required and take place in a context where risk factors are under control to the maximum extent.

#### High risk – RED

- Widespread infections in society and new contamination outbursts. Contacts between potential carriers should be avoided as much as possible.
