His oeuvre includes over 400 costumes and collaborations on various art projects.

The exhibition, which will be on view at the headquarters of the Council of the EU (Justus Lipsius and Europa buildings) and on the website of the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Slovenia, will be opened on Tuesday, 13 July 2021, at 3 p.m. by the Minister of Culture of the Republic of Slovenia Vasko Simoniti.

EuropeReadr OPENING CEREMONY AND LITERARY EVENT

WHEN: 14 July 2021 at 12.30 WHERE: Citizens' Garden of European Parliament

WHAT:

EuropeReadr is a digital platform established by Slovenia in cooperation with the network of European cultural institutes (EUNIC) within the framework of its presidency of the Council of the European Union. It offers free access to literary works of various genres in all the official languages of the European Union. The initiative aims to promote a reading culture, critical thinking, as well as to create public spaces for discussions on common European values, green and digital transformation of society, and our future.

Twelve members of the Brussels EUNIC cluster led by Slovenia will prepare the **grand opening of the EuropeReadr initiative on Wednesday, 14 July 2021, at 12.30 in the Citizens' Garden** in cooperation with the European Parliament and three associated partners, which will also include an art installation and a literary event. Participants will be addressed by Dr. Anže Logar, Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Slovenia, David-Maria Sassoli (TBC), President of the European Parliament, and EUNIC representative.

The art installation that will adorn the Citizens' Garden from 14 July to the end of September 2021 consists of twelve different types of indigenous Slovenian wood to symbolize the twelve partners of the EuropeReadr project within the EUNIC Brussels network. It was designed by the artistic duo Studio DREVO. The sculpture carries the message of coexistence and acceptance of the cultural diversity of the European Union.

A **literary event titled Writers on the Future of the Living** will follow the opening of the installation. Participants of the event will be Swedish writer Axel Lindén, Austrian writer Marlen Schachinger and Spanish writer Jorge Carrión. Julio Baquero-Cruz will lead the discussion.
